Program Description

Rehabilitation Nursing is a branch of nursing which typically deals with diagnosis of a client's response to actual or potential health problems affecting functional and self-reliance abilities and changing his life style. This program aims to increase functional ability and independency of the client and his family.

The graduates, together with other members of a rehabilitation team, can fulfill various tasks at different places by using principles of management, education, research, ethics and professional communication providing welfare, health information, health promotion, support, and self-reliance strategies for clients, their families and the community at risk.

The aims of this program are:

- Attaining maximum potential abilities and personal competence of the groups in need of rehabilitation nursing
- Gaining and maintaining an acceptable quality of life for clients
- Ensuring satisfaction of clients with particular needs
- Promoting coping abilities of clients and their families with life changes (due to disability)
- Restoring social functioning and returning to society
